Tennant Creek Women’s Refuge

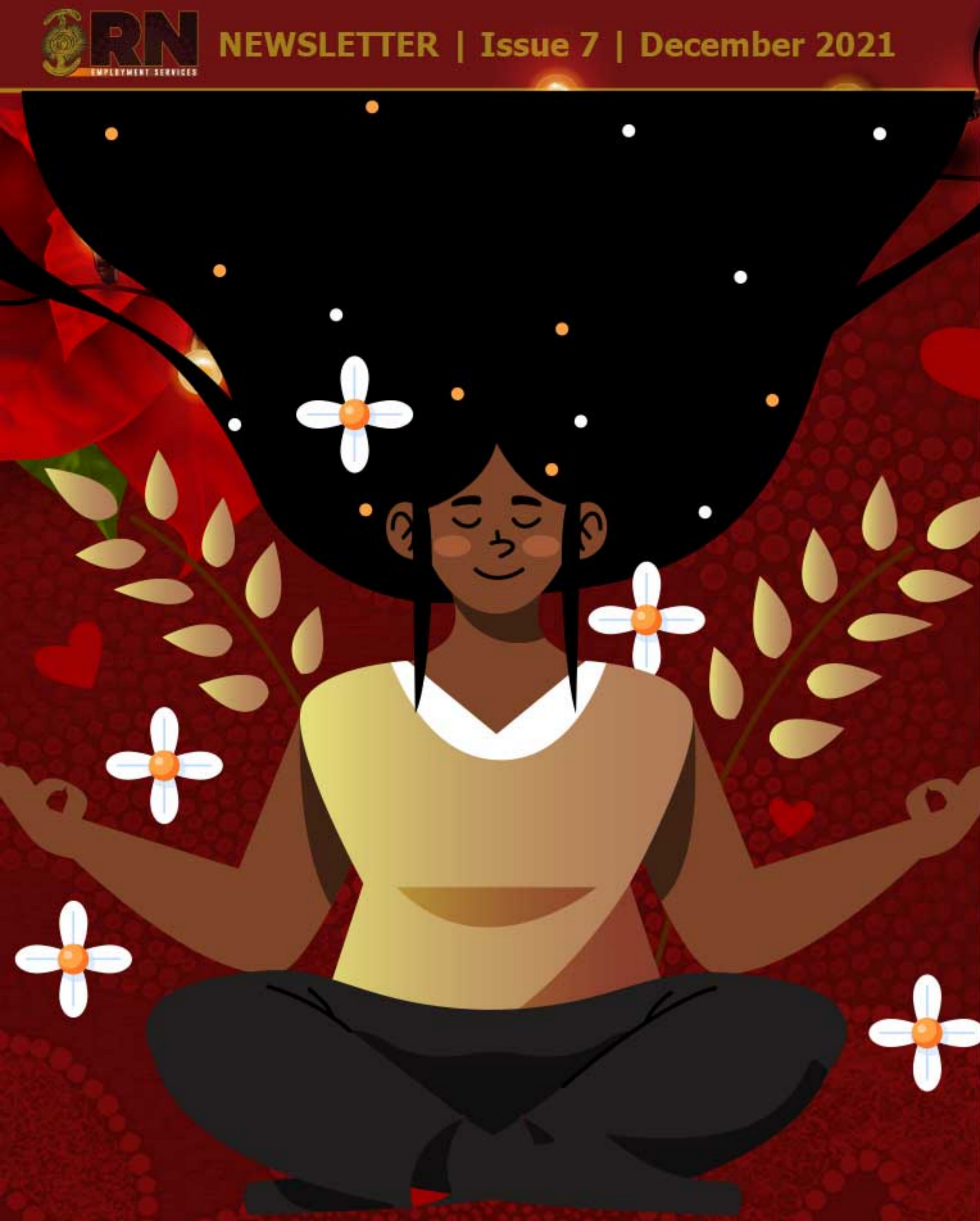
RN employment have been able to support the Tennant Creek Women’s Refuge in November with dropping off several boxes of clothing items.

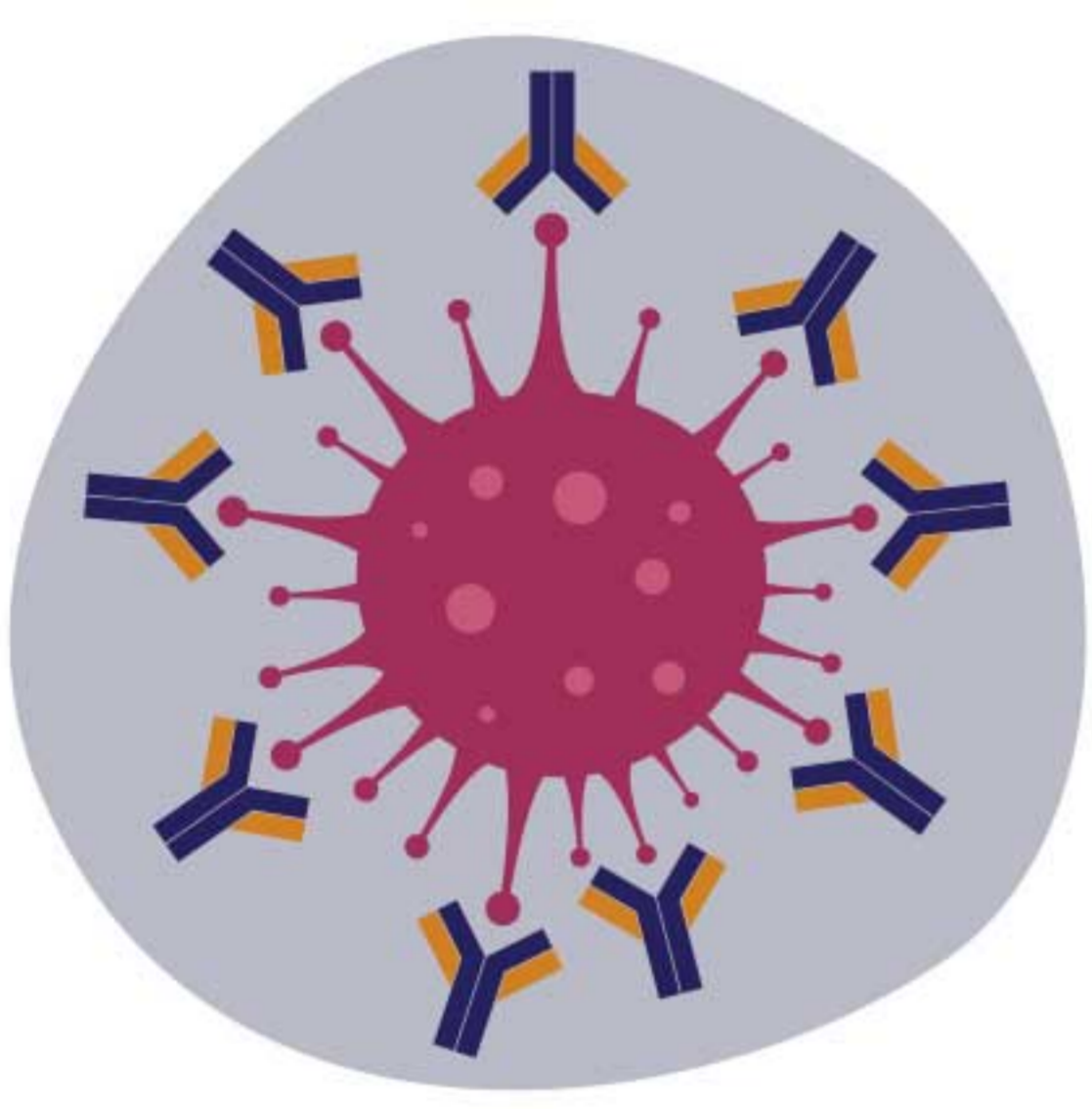

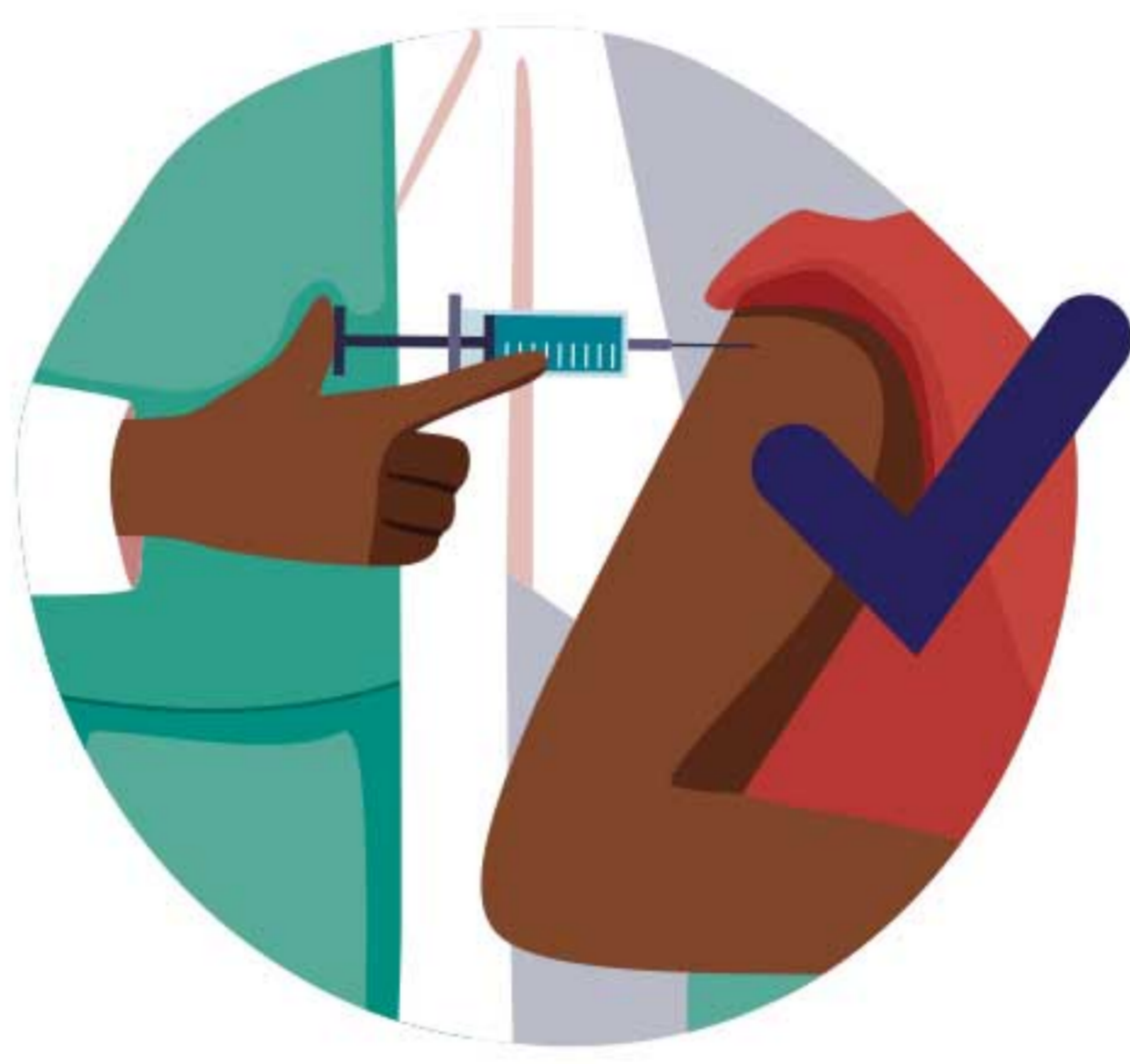

12+ years only

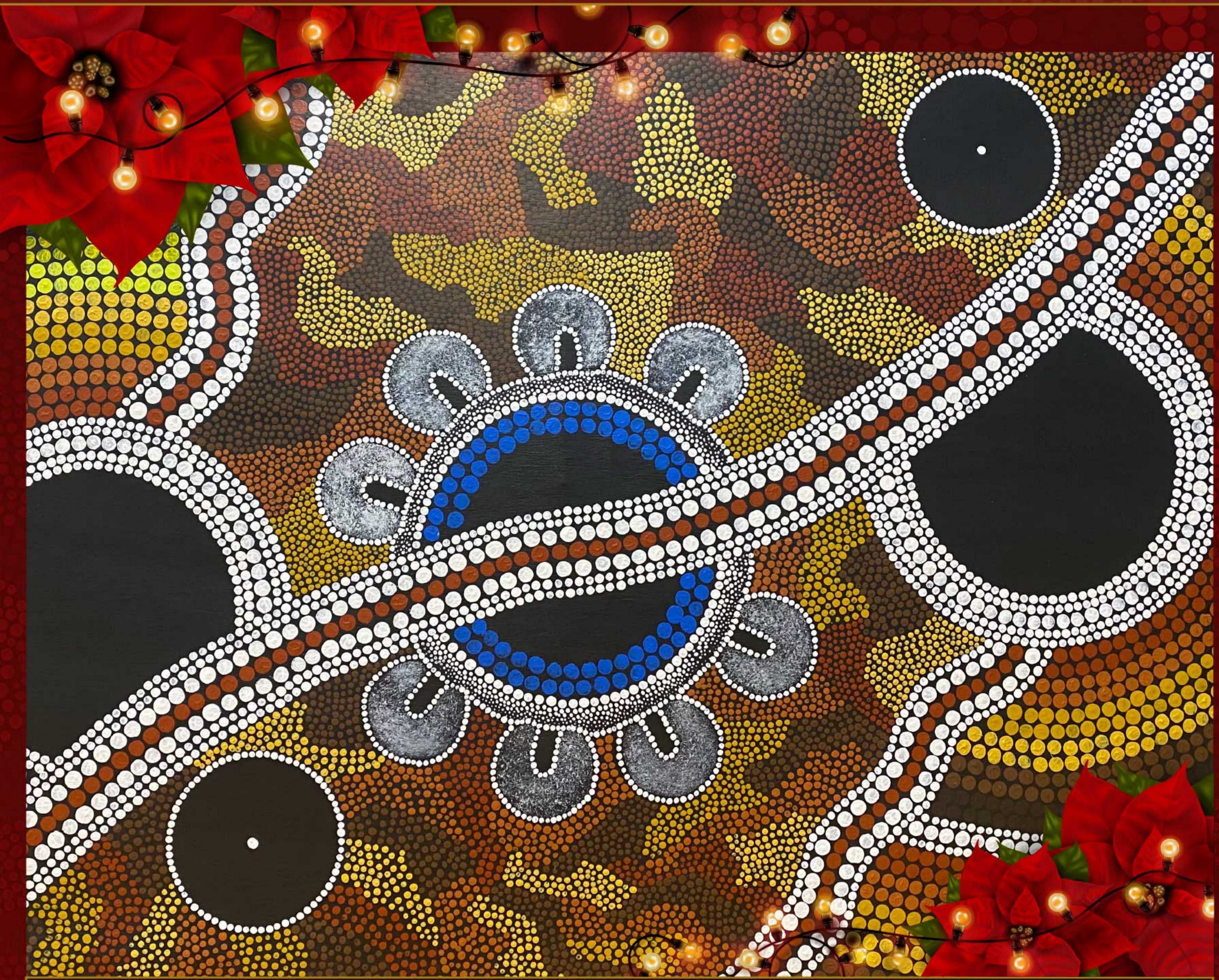
People 12 years and over can have the vaccine. Young people and children can get sick from COVID-19 too.
